Having spent my career doing businesses in regional Western Australia, I have become accustomed to being forgotten by both corporate and government decision makers.

Considered 'out-of-sight' and therefore 'out-of-mind', Western Australia and even more so, regional Western Australia are routinely skimmed over or completely ignored when planning investment strategies, implementing new policies or other major decisions that have significant impact on our business activities and community welfare.

This was starkly brought to the fore earlier this year when a Major Cyclone hit Karratha. It barely rated a blip on the national news cycle and the information presented was largely irrelevant to the issues faced or in some cases, completely false. This came hard on the back of months of intricate and nuanced reporting on every facet of the Eastern States bush fire crisis, where every tiny community was shone under a spotlight for all the world to see.
